Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were Personnel Records - Include a Pre-Employment Affidavit for Applicants for Employment as Specified in Texas Human Resources Code ?42.0563 (2), Evacuation-Must Practice Severe Weather Drill at Least Once Every 6 Months From Date of Last Severe Weather Drill (1), and Evacuation-Emergency Evacuation & Relocation Diagram Must Include Designated Location Inside Operation to Take Shelter From Threatening Weather (1). Of 5 total findings, 2 were critical.
