Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Operational Responsibilities - Designate a Qualified Full-time Child-care Administrator (3), Interior Space-Provide Living Space, Appropriate Furnishings, & Bathroom Facilities That Are Safe, Clean and Maintained in Good Repair (1), and Unauthorized Absence Evaluation - Must Conduct an Eval Every 6 Mths for Unauthorized Absences That Have Occurred During That Time Period (1). Of 5 total findings, 3 were critical.
