Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Supervision-The Caregiver Is Responsible for Ensuring Each Child's Safety and Well Being, Including Auditory And/or Visual Awareness of the Child (2), Beds and Bedding-mattresses Must Be Elevated From Floor and Have Covers or Protectors (1), and Children's rights-Adhere to the Child's Rights to Be Free From Being Subjected to Corporal Punishment (1). Of 4 total findings, 3 were critical.
