Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Caregiver Responsibility - Being Able to Intervene When Necessary to Ensure Child's Safety (1), Employee General responsibilities-Demonstrate Competency, Prudent Judgment, Self-control in Presence of Children and When Performing Assigned Tasks (1), and Bathrooms-Must Be Maintained in Good Repair & Kept Clean (1). Of 4 total findings, 4 were critical.
