Across 5 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Child/caregiver ratio-Caregiver May Care for 5 Children if Any Require Tx Svcs, 8 Children if Not; Children Under 5 Yrs Old Count as 2 Children (1), Evacuation-Must Post the Emergency Evacuation & Relocation Diagram in a Prominent/visible Location in All Buildings (1), and Medication Record - Must Include Reason Medication Was Prescribed, for Prescription Medication (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
