Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were AP Serious Incdt-Report to Licensing No Later Than 24 Hours After Injury/illness That Warrants Treatment by a Medical Professional or Hospitalization (1), Administration of Medication-Store Medication in the Original Container Unless There Is an Additional Container with the Same Label & Instructions (1), and Employee General responsibilities-Demonstrate Competency, Prudent Judgment, Self-control in Presence of Children and When Performing Assigned Tasks (1). Of 3 total findings, 3 were critical.
