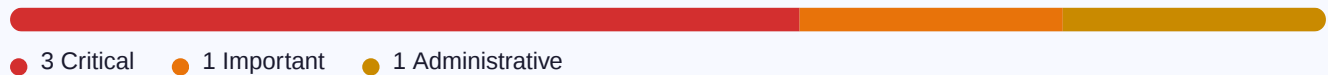

Most recent inspection: Mar 6, 2026



Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were EBI Implementation-Caregiver Must Minimize Risk of Physical Discomfort, Harm, or Pain to the Child (2), Other Prohibited Punishments-any Harsh, Cruel, Unusual, Unnecessary, Demeaning, or Humiliating Discipline/punishment (1), and Employee General responsibilities-Demonstrate Competency, Prudent Judgment, Self-control in Presence of Children and When Performing Assigned Tasks (1). Of 5 total findings, 3 were critical.
