Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Supervision Ensures Each Child?s Safety, Well-being, Including Physical Proximity and Auditory or Visual Awareness of Each Child?s on Going Activity (2), Prohibited Punishments - Using Harsh, Abusive or Profane Language (1), and Reporting Suspected Abuse, Neglect, Exploitation-May Not Delegate Responsibility to Report (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
