Across 4 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were Serious Incident-Report to Licensing No Later Than 6 Hours After Determining Unauthorized Absence of a Child 13 Yrs Old or Older. (1), Caregiver Responsibility - Providing the Level of Supervision Necessary to Ensure Each Child's Safety and Well-being (1), and Child/caregiver ratio-A Caregiver Must Be Awake When Caring for a Child Needing Constant Supervision (1). Of 5 total findings, 3 were critical.
