Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Each Caregiver and the Director Must Have Current Training in Pediatric CPR (2), Reduction of Child/caregiver Naptime Ratio by 50% Allowed, If 13 or More Children in Care, Children Are 18 Mo. or Older and Other Standards Met (1), and AP Must Place Infants in Face Up Sleeping Position or Must Have Completed and Signed Sleep Exception Form for the Infant (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
