Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Medication Record-must Include Accurate Daily Count of Each Prescribed Medication, Unless Operate on a Cottage Home Model (2), Hand-washing-Provide Hand-washing Sinks Equipped with Soap & a Personal Towel, Single-use Disposable Towels, or Hot Air Hand Dryers (1), and Other Prohibited Punishments-pinching, Pulling Hair, Biting, or Shaking a Child (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
