Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Children's rights-Adhere to the Child's Rights to Be Free of Abuse, Neglect, and Exploitation (2), Corporal Punishment-May Not Use/threaten Corporal Punishment, Such as Hitting/spanking, Forced Exercise, Holding Physical Position, Unproductive Work. (1), and Child-care Administrator responsibilities-Ensuring That Operation Complies with Applicable Rules of Chapter 748 and Other Applicable Rules and Laws. (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
