Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were AP Serious Incdt-Report to Licensing No Later Than 24 Hours After Injury/illness That Warrants Treatment by a Medical Professional or Hospitalization (1), EBI Documentation-Must Include the Name of the Person(s) Who Observed the Child (1), and Driver & Passengers Must Follow All Laws When Driving, Including Laws on Use of Child Passenger Safety Seat Systems, Seat Belts & Liability Insurance (1). Of 5 total findings, 3 were critical.
