Across 4 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were Records Available for Licensing-all Active Records Immediately Available for Review and Reproduction (2), Initial Service Plan-Service Planning Team Must Include at Least One of the Child's Current Caregivers (1), and Children's Rights-rights to Good Care and Treatment That Meets the Child's Needs in the Most Family-like Setting Possible (1). Of 5 total findings, 2 were critical.
