Across 4 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were Supervision-When Supervising a Child, a Caregiver Must Take Into Account the Surrounding Circumstances, Hazards, and Risks (2), Supervision-Video Cameras May Not Be Used with Children Other Than Infants and Toddlers Unless Parent or Person Legally Authorized Gives Consent (1), and Child Placement Staff responsibilities-Monitor and Provide Support Services to Foster Parents, Initiate Development/corrective/adverse Action Plans (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
