Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Reporting Serious Incident - All Serious Incident Reports to Licensing Must Be Made to the Texas Abuse & Neglect Hotline (1), Serious Incident Documentation-Includes Names of All Adults Involved and Their Role in Relation to the Child(ren) (1), and Child/caregiver ratio-Caregiver May Care for 5 Children if Any Require Tx Svcs, 8 Children if Not; Children Under 5 Yrs Old Count as 2 Children (1). Of 5 total findings, 3 were critical.
