Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Child/caregiver ratio-Caregiver May Care for 5 Children if Any Require Tx Svcs, 8 Children if Not; Children Under 5 Yrs Old Count as 2 Children (1), Caregiver Responsibility - Providing the Level of Supervision Necessary to Ensure Each Child's Safety and Well-being (1), and Serious Incident Documentation-Includes Names or Other Means of Identifying Witnesses to the Incident, if Any (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
