Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were Operational Responsibilities - Designate a Qualified Full-time Child-care Administrator (1), Food Preparation-Must Have a Thermometer in Refrigerators & Store Refrigerated Food at 40 Degrees Fahrenheit or Below (1), and Evacuation-Emergency Evacuation & Relocation Diagram Must Include Designated Location Inside Operation to Take Shelter From Threatening Weather (1). Of 4 total findings, 2 were critical.
