Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Supervisory Visits- Documentation Must Be Signed by Each Foster Parent Present for Visit and Child Placement Staff Conducting Visit (2), Initial Service Plan-Caregiver Instructions Must Include Specific Information About Child's Level of Supervision (1), and Serious Incident-Report to Licensing No Later Than 6 Hours After Determining Unauthorized Absence of a Child 13 Yrs Old or Older. (1). Of 5 total findings, 3 were critical.
