Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Serious Incident-Report to Licensing No Later Than 6 Hours After Determining Unauthorized Absence of a Child 13 Yrs Old or Older. (2), Annual Training Timeline-Each Person Must Complete Required Annual Training Within 12 Months From Date of Employment or Date Verified as Foster Parent (1), and Child Placement Management Staff responsibilities-Review, Approve, Sign and Date Discharge or Transfer Plans and Summaries (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
