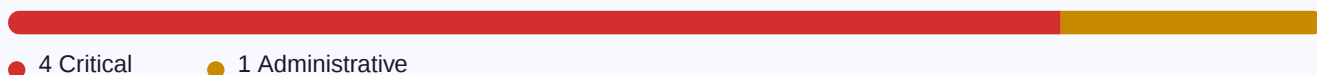

Across 5 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Medication Record-must Include Accurate Daily Count of Each Prescribed Medication, Unless Operate on a Cottage Home Model (2), Initial Service Plan-Must Give the Child's Parent(s) at Least Two Weeks Advance Notice of the Meeting (1), and Operational Responsibilities - Designate a Qualified Full-time Child-care Administrator (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
