Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Child/caregiver ratio-Each Group Must Have Enough Caregivers for That Group Who Are Not Caring for Other Children or Doing Administrative Work (2), Physical Site-Buildings Must Be Clean and in Good Repair. (2), and Preliminary Service Plan-For Child Receiving Treatment Services, Include a Description of Child's Immediate Educational, Medical, and Dental Needs (1). Of 5 total findings, 3 were critical.
