Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were AP Administration of Medication-Administer Medications According to Label Instructions or a Prescribing Health-care Professional's Subsequent Orders (1), Supervisory Visits-must Have Supervisory Visits with Both Foster Parents, if Applicable, at Least Once Every Six Months (1), and Background Check Validation - Every 3 Months Each Operation, Other Than a Licensed, Registered, or Listed Home, Must Validate Current List (1). Of 5 total findings, 3 were critical.
