Across 5 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were EBI Documentation-Caregiver Must Document EBI in Child's Record as Soon as Possible, but No Later Than 24 Hours After Initiation of the Intervention (1), Food Preparation-Food & Drinks Must Be of Safe Quality, Stored, Prepared, Distributed, & Served Under Sanitary & Safe Conditions (1), and Serious Incident-Report to Licensing No Later Than 6 Hours After Determining Unauthorized Absence of a Child 13 Yrs Old or Older. (1). Of 5 total findings, 1 was critical.
