Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Placement agreement-Must Include the Reason for Placement & Anticipated Length of Time in Care (1), Admission Documentation-Includes Known Contraindications to the Use of Restraint (1), and Food Preparation-Food Must Be Protected From Contamination (1). Of 5 total findings, 2 were critical.
