Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Reduction of Child/caregiver Naptime Ratio by 50% Allowed, If 13 or More Children in Care, Children Are 18 Mo. or Older and Other Standards Met (1), Required Records Maintained and Made Available - Personnel and Training Records (1), and Each Caregiver and the Director Must Have Current Training in Pediatric First Aid with Rescue Breathing and Choking. (1). Of 4 total findings, 2 were critical.
