Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Physical Site- Buildings Must Be Structurally Sound and Not Pose a Risk to the Health and Safety of Children. (3), Protective Surfacing-Must Install Protective Surfacing in All Required Use Zones (1), and Sanitation Inspection-Sanitation Official Must Conduct Sanitation Inspection at Least Once Every 12 Months From Date of Last Inspection (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
