Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Corporal Punishment-May Not Use/threaten Corporal Punishment, Such as Hitting/spanking, Forced Exercise, Holding Physical Position, Unproductive Work. (1), General Medical requirements-A Child in Care Must Receive Medical Care as Needed for Ongoing Maintenance of Medical Health (1), and Annual Training-Each Caregiver Must Complete 2hrs Annual Training on Trauma Informed Care. (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
