Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Supervision Ensures Each Child?s Safety, Well-being, Including Physical Proximity and Auditory or Visual Awareness of Each Child?s on Going Activity (1), Required Immunizations (1), and Responsibilities of Employees and Caregivers -Demonstrate Competency, Good Judgment, Self-control (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
