Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Birth Parent Preparation-2 Face-to-face Contact Prior to Relinquishment of Rights Over 2 or More Days; 1 Contact After Birth; Justify No Face-to-face (1), Adoptive Home Screening-Interviews Must Include at Least One with Any Other Person Living with the Family Full or Part Time (1), and Annual Training- Must Include One Hour of Training on Prevention, Recognition, and Reporting on Child Abuse, Neglect, and Exploitation. (1). Of 3 total findings, 1 was critical.
