Across 5 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were AP Serious Incdt-Report to Licensing No Later Than 24 Hours After Injury/illness That Warrants Treatment by a Medical Professional or Hospitalization (1), Nutrition-Must Not Be More Than 14 Hours Between Last Meal or Snack of the Day and the Serving of the First Meal of the Following Day (1), and Interior Space-Provide Living Space, Appropriate Furnishings, & Bathroom Facilities That Are Safe, Clean and Maintained in Good Repair (1). Of 5 total findings, 5 were critical.
