Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Other Prohibited Discipline-Confining a Child to a Highchair, Box, or Other Similar Furniture or Equipment as Discipline or Punishment (1), Corporal Punishment-May Not Use/threaten Corporal Punishment, Such as Hitting/spanking, Forced Exercise, Holding Physical Position, Unproductive Work. (1), and Disaster and Emergency-must Conduct a Fire Drill Each Year, So Children Are Able to Exit Home Within 3 Minutes (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
