Across 4 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were Other Prohibited Punishments-subjecting a Child to Abusive or Profane Language (2), Child/caregiver ratio-Caregiver May Care for 5 Children if Any Require Tx Svcs, 8 Children if Not; Children Under 5 Yrs Old Count as 2 Children (1), and Serious Incident-Report to Licensing No Later Than 24 Hours After Becoming Aware That Child Is Indicted, Charged, or Arrested or When Police Respond. (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
