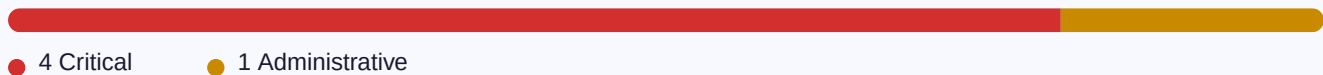

Across 5 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were AP CPA Administrator Responsibilities- Ensure That the Operation Complies with Current Heightened Monitoring Plans. (2), Medication Storage-Store Medication in a Locked Container (2), and Babysitter/Overnight care/Respite Care Providers Policy- Must Develop Policies for Both In-home and Out-of-home Care (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
