Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Responsibilities of Employees and Caregivers -Demonstrate Competency, Good Judgment, Self-control (1), Maintenance of Building, Grounds and Equipment (1), and Written Operational Policies - Parent Rights (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
