Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were AP Serious Incdt-Report to Licensing No Later Than 24 Hours After Injury/illness That Warrants Treatment by a Medical Professional or Hospitalization (1), Fire Extinguisher-Fire Extinguisher That Has Been Used or Has Lost Operating Pressure Must Be Serviced or Replaced Immediately with Equivalent Unit (1), and Food Preparation-Food Must Be Thawed in the Refrigerator, in Cold Water in a Leak-proof Bag, or in the Microwave (1). Of 5 total findings, 5 were critical.
