Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were Annual Training- Caregiver's Who Administer Psychotropic Medication Must Complete Psychotropic Medication Training Annually. (1), Operational Responsibilities - Maintain Current, True, Accurate, and Complete Records (1), and Medical Requirements-Ensure Child Has a Medical Exam 30 Days After the Date of Admission or Documented Exam Within Last Year (1). Of 5 total findings, 2 were critical.
