

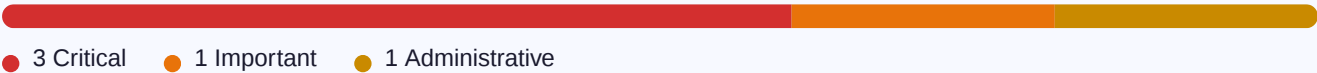

(2), Physical Site-Equipment and Furniture Must Be Safe for Children and Must Be Kept Clean and in Good Repair (1), and Medication Record - Must Include Date (Day/month/year) & Time Each Medication Was Administered (1). Of 5 total findings, 3 were critical.
