Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Child/caregiver ratio-Caregiver May Care for 5 Children if Any Require Tx Svcs, 8 Children if Not; Children Under 5 Yrs Old Count as 2 Children (1), Evacuation-Emergency Evacuation & Relocation Diagram Must Include Designated Location Inside Operation to Take Shelter From Threatening Weather (1), and Personnel records-Background Check Results Must Be Kept Confidential and Protected From Unauthorized Access or Release (1). Of 5 total findings, 3 were critical.
