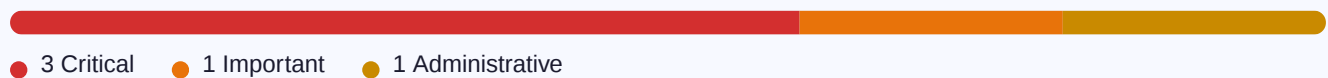

Across 3 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were Employee and Caregiver responsibilities-Competency, Prudent Judgment, Self-control in Presence of Children and When Performing Assigned Tasks (2), Verification Certificate- Specifies the Ages and Gender(s) of Foster Children for Which the Home Is Verified (1), and Children's rights-Adhere to the Child's Right to Have Personal Care, Hygiene, and Grooming Equipment/supplies and Training in How to Use (1). Of 5 total findings, 3 were critical.
