Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were AP Administration of Medication-Administer Medications According to Label Instructions or a Prescribing Health-care Professional's Subsequent Orders (1), Medication Record-Maintain Cumulative Record of Prescription Medications Dispensed to Child, Include Nonprescription Meds for Child Under Five Yrs Old (1), and Service Plan Review and Update-To Review and Update a Service Plan, Evaluate Possible Effectiveness and Side Effects of Psychotropic Meds (1). Of 5 total findings, 3 were critical.
