Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Sanitation Inspection-Sanitation Official Must Conduct Sanitation Inspection at Least Once Every 12 Months From Date of Last Inspection (1), Operational Responsibilities-Maintain Liability Insurance Coverage in the Amount of \$300,000 for Each Occurrence of Negligence (1), and Child Must Be Immediately Treated by Health Prof, Contact Emergency Svcs or Take Child to ER for Injury/illness Requiring Treatment by a Health Prof. (1). Of 5 total findings, 4 were critical.
