Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with R381-100-6(12)(a) by Not Having Complete Children's Records. In the Facility, the Admission and Health Assessment Forms for One Child Had Not Been Reviewed, Updated, and Signed Annually by a Parent or Guardian. This Was a Repeat Noncompliance as Noted on 12/23 (2), The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Having Toxic or Hazardous Chemicals Accessible to Children. In the 2's Classroom, There Were Disinfectant Wipes in a Cupboard. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (2), and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with R381-100-11(1) by Having Children Who Were Not Actively Supervised. In the Preschool Room, the Caregiver Did Not Know the Number of Children in Their Care (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
