Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-11(6)(a)-(e) by Not Ensuring That Napping Children Are Supervised with a Camera That Is Positioned So the Staff Can See the Child. In the Napping Room, the Camera Was Not Positioned So That the Caregiver Could See a Napping Child. (1) and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-10(3)(a)-(c) by Not Ensuring That When an Infant or Toddler Is Mixed with Older Children the Group Has Eight or Fewer Children. At the Facility, There Were Toddlers Mixed with a Group of More Than Eight Children. (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
