Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-13(9)(b) by Having Toxic or Hazardous Chemicals Accessible to Children. In the Kitchen, There Were Chemical Cleaners in an Unlocked Cabinet. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance as Noted on January 9, 2025. (2), The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-11(9)(b) by Not Maintaining Security and Supervision of Children. At the Facility, There Was a Child Who Was Not Signed In. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance as Noted on April 14, 2023. (1), and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Ensuring That Children Younger Than Two Years Old Are Cared for in an Area That Is Physically Separated From Older Children When There Are More Than 8 Children. At the Facility, There Were 3 Children Under the Age of Two in a Group of 14 Child (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
