Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Having a Gap in the Fence Greater Than 5 by 5 Inches. On the South Side of the Playground, There Was a Gap Greater Than 5 by 5 Inches Where the Fence Was Broken. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (2), The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Having Prescription Medications Without the Original Pharmacy Label or Container. At the Facility, One EpiPen Did Not Have the Original Pharmacy Label or Container. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (1), and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Having Toxic or Hazardous Chemicals Accessible to Children. In the 2s Class, There Were Disinfectant Wipes on a Shelf. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
