Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with R380-80-5(10) by Failing to Provide Adequate Supervision Based on the Child's Abilities. During an Inspection on 1/29/2026, the Investigator Identified That a School-age Child Was Transported to the Incorrect Elementary School. This Resulted in the Child Walki (1) and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Ensuring That Each Vehicle Used for Transporting Children Contained First Aid Supplies, Including at Least Antiseptic, Bandages, and Tweezers. In One of the Vans Used for Transporting the Children, There Were No First Aid Supplies. This Was A (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
