At the Time of the Inspection, There Were Records That Were Not Available for Review. (3), The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-17(1) by Having Medications Accessible to Children. In the Toddler Room, There Were Medications Accessible to Children. (1), and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with Rule R381-100-8(2)(d) by Allowing Individuals to Be Involved with Child Care in the Program Before Receiving Notification of Eligibility From Office of Licensing. In the Facility, One Individual Was Involved in Caregiving Duties and Counting in Ratio Before Ge (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
