Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Ensuring That at Least One Staff Member in Each Transporting Vehicle Had a Current First Aid and CPR Certification. At the Facility, There Was a Driver Who Did Not Have First Aid and CPR Certification. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (1) and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Not Supplying the Vehicle with First Aid Supplies. In Bus #3, There Were No First Aid Supplies That Contained at Least Antiseptic, Bandages, or Tweezers. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
