Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Exceeding the Mixed-age Ratio of Older Toddlers and Two-year-old Children. In the 2's Classroom, One Toddler Was Mixed with 9 Two-year-olds with One Caregiver. (1) and The Provider Was Out of Compliance with This Rule by Having Inadequate Protective Cushioning. On the School-age Playground, the Shredded Rubber in the Use Zone Did Not Meet the Depth Requirement of Six Inches. This Was a Repeat Rule Noncompliance. (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
